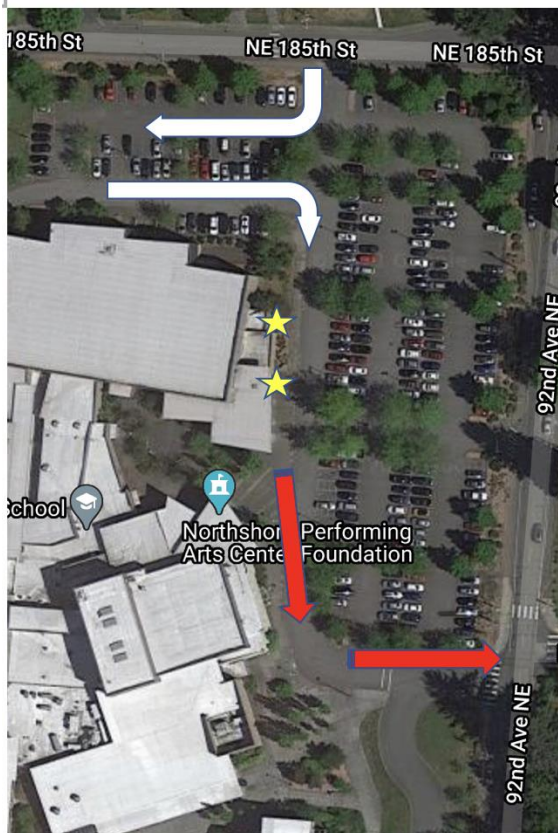


TESTING PROTOCOL: BATCH TESTING IN GROUPS OF 25

The district is partnering with Gingko Bio to perform pooled testing in groups of up to 25 people.

Each person tested needs to have a signed permission form which they will be expected to bring with them to testing. **For minors, this form must be signed by their parent or legal guardian.**

- ▶ Testing – will be required for all coaches and athletes before they can participate. The testing will be provided by the school district.
- ▶ Testing will be Wednesday nights from 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm
- ▶ Always remain in your car during testing and follow designated route below.
- ▶ Students under 18 need parental consent for COVID Screening. No consent/no test/no play. Hard Stop!
- ▶ If you have had COVID or believe you had COVID based on symptoms but were not tested or do not have documentation, please contact your Athletic Director for alternate testing.
- ▶ If you have been COVID positive in the last three months and can provide documentation from your health care provider, you will be exempt from weekly testing. After three months you will need to do test at District office on a case-by-case basis. Information will be sent out via Final Forms to schedule an appointment.



MISSING A TEST DAY

- ▶ Must provide a test within one week of their next contact with students and coaches. For example, miss a Wednesday – need to be tested between that day and the next workout to be cleared.
- ▶ COVID tests that are approved are from your healthcare provider or from the list of test sites provided by the Department of Health.
- ▶ Monday test days are for positive batch test confirmations only.
- ▶ If you are traveling to Europe, Brazil, Ireland, the UK you will need to follow the federal mandated quarantine protocol.

RETESTING IF A POSITIVE TEST HAPPENS (BATCH TESTING)

- ▶ Individual will be contact by a district employee.
- ▶ Individual Retest for Positive tests happens on Mondays – By appointment only at District Office
- ▶ Individuals will be notified ifthey are positive or negative from the retest.
- ▶ Negative test results communicated to AD for return to participation.
- ▶ Individuals will not be allowed back on campus until they are given clearance.
